Sacrament of Baptism

Baptism of adults and youth follows the Church's traditional "Catechumenate," a gradual acquaintance with Catholic life leading to Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil. Baptism of infants and pre-school children is celebrated on the third Sunday of each month at 1:00 PM (except during Lent), and at the Easter Vigil. Parents (or expecting parents) must be registered parishioners, call at least six weeks in advance, and participate in a brief parent preparation held regularly. Lenten Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence.

As a sign of our penance, as Catholics aged 14 and up, we are called to preserve the custom of <u>abstinence</u> from meat on the Fridays during Lent. <u>Fasting</u> during Lent refers to the quantity of food consumed. Catholics aged 18 to 58 are called to observe by eating only one full meal per day. These are not intended as laws binding under pain of sin, but as customs from which we will not hold ourselves lightly excused. They are expressions of our desire to be converted in our hearts, to be reconciled with each other, and to love our neighbor.

This year we will follow our regular weekday Mass schedule during Lent, having a 7:45 am Mass on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday and a 7:45 Communion Service on Wednesday. 


