

LENT



The season of Lent is fast approaching. It begins on Ash Wednesday (Feb. 26th) and ends on Holy Thursday Evening with The Mass of the Lord's Supper.

Traditionally Lent is a season in which prayer, the reception of the Sacraments, and charity are emphasized. Also, Catholics are to

observe the practice of fast and abstinence for Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. And as a sign of our penance, we preserve the custom of abstinence from meat on the Fridays of Lent.

Abstinence binds all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Fasting binds all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Fasting refers to the quantity of food eaten. Traditionally fasting calls for only one full meal per day and two smaller meals.

Retaining fasting and abstinence during the designated days of Lent is not to be interpreted as laws binding under pain of sin, but as customs from which we will not hold ourselves lightly excused. They are expressions of our desire to be converted in our hearts, to be reconciled with God and with our neighbor and as a time of spiritual renewal.


