

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost which concludes the Easter Season. Pentecost is recognized as the birthday of the Church and also the fulfilment of Jesus' promise to send us the Holy Spirit. Obviously this year's feast is unlike any other that we have ever experienced. However, that being said, we are getting closer to reopening churches.

For those of you who did not see the Evangelist last week, I thought it would be reassuring to provide an update on where things stand for our re-opening. As you know, the Governor has given permission for the resumption of church gatherings of up to 10 people. Therefore, small baptisms, weddings, and funerals can now take place. Additionally, our parish, like all those in the Albany Diocese, must prepare a Re-Opening Plan which will meet the guidelines for a safe resumption to services. Rest assured, we will do everything possible to keep the members of our parish community healthy and safe. I will communicate more information about the Re-opening plan and related dates as they become available.

Also, the Bishops Appeal is taking place, though the Diocese was forced to push off the "official" kick off. If you sent your Diocesan Appeal envelope into the rectory, I want to thank you for that contribution. Your donation was processed and/or forwarded to the Stewardship office. You will likely receive another correspondence from the Stewardship office in the weeks to come.

I continue to pray for all the members of our community. I hope you are well and I look forward to seeing you again in the very near future.


