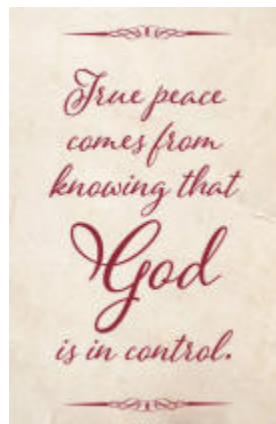

Dear Parishioners,

I know many of you are looking forward to the day when you can return to church for Mass. For that to happen, Governor Cuomo must approve large group church gatherings. In turn, Bishop Scharfenberger will be looking to see that parishes have taken the necessary steps to insure readiness and compliance with diocesan guidelines and procedures. Here at St. Mary's we have begun to prepare for that day. We have a Reopening Coordinating Committee which is in the process of developing our parish's plan. It goes without saying that our plan will be mindful of all CDC and NYS Health Department directives in order to safeguard your health and well being.

Please know that Bishop Scharfenberger has extended the temporary suspension of the obligation to attend mass until further notice. Therefore anyone who does not feel it is safe enough to venture to church is not expected to. I encourage you to view our recorded mass each week on our parish's YouTube channel. There is a link on our website to the channel for your convenience, simply visit www.stmaryswaterford.org and click the link for "Weekend Liturgy". Additional, we are working on installing the technology needed to livestream mass, which we hope to do shortly. Our church continues to be open each morning, 7 days a week, 7 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for private prayer.

You should already have received a letter from me regarding our church's reopening and the need for volunteers to assist in order to re-open safely in accordance with guidelines. Prior to our first "public" mass, I will be sending another correspondence which will explain our plan in much greater detail.

I would like to offer my heartfelt thanks to all those who have continued to contribute to the parish by way of a weekly offertory. *Your generosity has truly amazed me!* Finally, as we celebrate this weekend the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, let us be mindful that we celebrate the Mystery of a God whose life we share in. We indeed cherish our faith and our belief in a God who is always there for us and touches our lives in so many marvelous ways. Let us also offer our thanks and gratitude to the Lord for His many gifts and blessings to us and most especially thank Him for the gift of life, and love, and joy in a Trinity of Divine Persons - God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
