

prayers she offered continually for her wayward son.

Augustine was born in a Roman province in 354 and educated at Carthage. As a young man he became

interested in philosophy. By 396 he had become bishop of Hippo, and his sermons and writings gained fame, notably his "Confessions". His notions of God's grace, free will and Original Sin had a great influence on Christian theology. Augustine, known as the spiritual father of the Augustinian Order, died in 430.

Monica was born in Tagaste, present day Algeria, in 331, to a

deeply Christian family. Strong of character as well as of faith, she sought to guide her husband and son in their human and Christian development most of all by her own

example and prayer but, when necessary, also by her persuasive words and diligent actions. Shortly after Augustine's baptism in 387, Monica died and her remains are laid to rest at Basilica of Saint Augustine in Rome.


RIOF pledge reminders are delayed due to some initial printing difficulties. The Diocesan Stewardship Office apologies for the inconvenience.


