


#### Gaudete Sunday

The Third Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday. Its name is taken from the entrance antiphon of the Mass, which is: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again

I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near."

Gaudete is Latin meaning
"rejoice"; it's also pronounced
with three syllables;
gau-de-te. Advent is the
season of preparing for the arrival of the Lord Jesus and by the
third Sunday of Advent, we are
most of the way through the
season.

It is appropriate to rejoice as we see the goal of the season approaching: "The Lord is near." The liturgical color for this Sunday is rose or violet. Therefore the celebrant will wear a rose colored vestment and the third candle on the advent wreath is rose colored as well.





Paul encourages the Thessalonians to be thankful to God and be active in their newly found faith in Christ by following his moral imperatives. How are you putting your faith into practice during this Advent?

#### Gospel Reading

John tells us that the religious leaders in Jerusalem questioned the identity of John the Baptist, wondering if he was the Messiah, Elijah, or the Prophet who Moses prophesied would come. John the Baptist responds in humility, with a clear sense of his own call. Do you humbly accept God's call in your life?


## ST MARY OF THE ASSUMPTION MISSION STATEMENT
