



#### Dear Friends.

I would like to take a moment to address a few questions that some of you may have regarding the temporary suspension of weekend liturgies.

Data from both the New York State Health Department as well as the Center for Disease Control suggests that the period between January 11th and the first week of February will be marked by the highest level of COVID-19 infections and, consequently, the highest number of deaths in New York State since the pandemic began.

Those facts, combined with the number of families we know locally who have been affected by the virus since Christmas, were the catalyst for my decision to suspend public masses.

It is my hope that the suspension would insulate our community from the worst this pandemic has thrown at us. I am also hopeful that more members of our parish community will receive the vaccine in the weeks to come, further protecting all of you from this disease.

Barring any significant deterioration in the situation, St. Mary's and St. Augustine's Churches will commence public masses on the weekend of February 13th (4 PM) and 14th (8 AM).

Though the church has signage regarding the virus, please take note of the symptoms and stay home if you are experiencing any such symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, loss of taste or smell, muscle or body aches. Additionally, please refrain from attending if you have traveled outside the area in the past 14 days, especially to and from areas that are on our state's quarantine list.

And, of course, please be mindful that the dispensation from the obligation to attend mass is still in effect.

I continue to pray for all the members of our community. May God protect you during these uncertain times.

## 2020 End of Year Donor Substantiation Tax Letter


