As we work to restore the normalcy that was part of life a year ago, some of the customary aspects of mass will be resuming. Therefore, as of the start of the Sacred Triduum, April 1, 2021, communion will no longer be distributed at the conclusion of mass but rather at what has always been the traditional time for communion.

We are, however, still required to ensure that we all maintain 6 foot of distance between ourselves and others. Please be diligent and conscious of how closely you are to others as you come forward for communion.




