
St. Mary's Cemetery Cleanup

Sacrament of the Eucharist

As of April 11, 2021, the second Sunday of Easter, communion will be distributed at the customary time during mass. It is still necessary for all of us to maintain 6 feet of distance from others while coming forward for communion. In an effort to ensure social distancing, the process to distribute communion will be as follows:

Eucharistic ministers will be positioned at the side aisles to administer the Eucharist.

Those seated in the side pews will come forward first, walking up and back by way of the side aisles. We kindly ask these parishioners to walk forward next to the center pews, and walk back to your seat. Hopefully, this will prevent anyone from having to cross through the communion line.

Once those seated to the far left and right have received communion,

folks seated in the center may come forward, also by way of the side aisle. After receiving the Eucharist, these parishioners will return to their pew by way of the center aisle.

Thank you for your continued cooperation. We continue to adapt our procedures as things slowly begin to normalize but truly appreciate your understanding.

Think of what is above, not what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. (Col 3:2-3)


