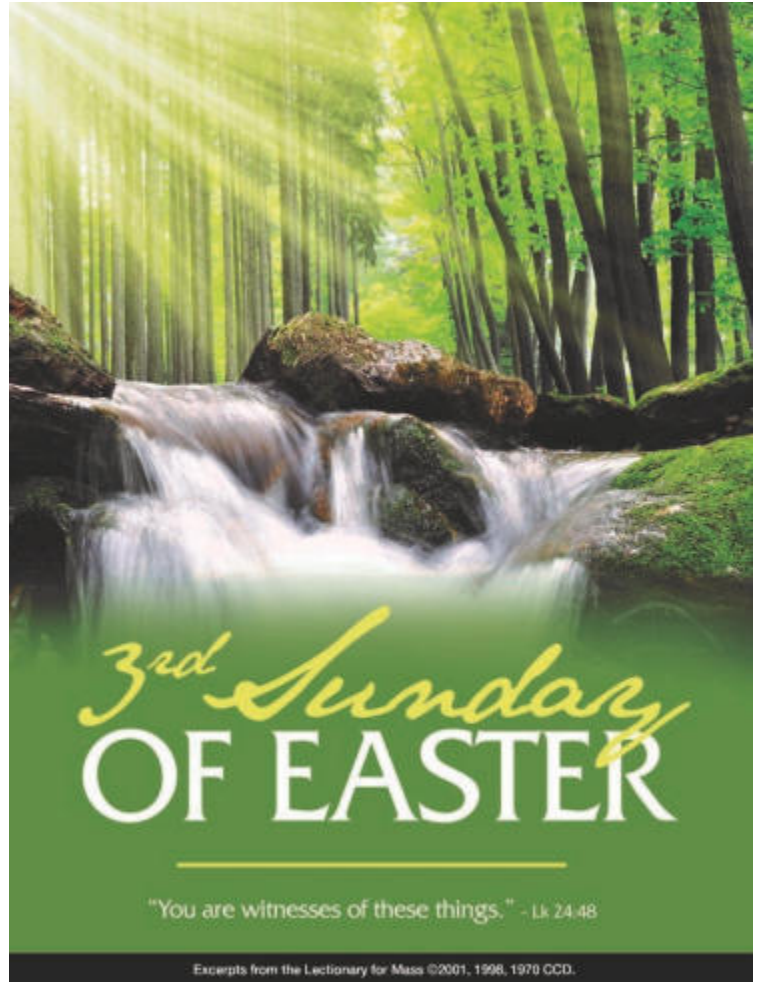

Sacrament of the Eucharist



Please maintain 6 feet of distance from others while coming forward for communion.

Communion will proceed as follows:

Eucharistic ministers will be positioned at the side aisles to administer the Eucharist.

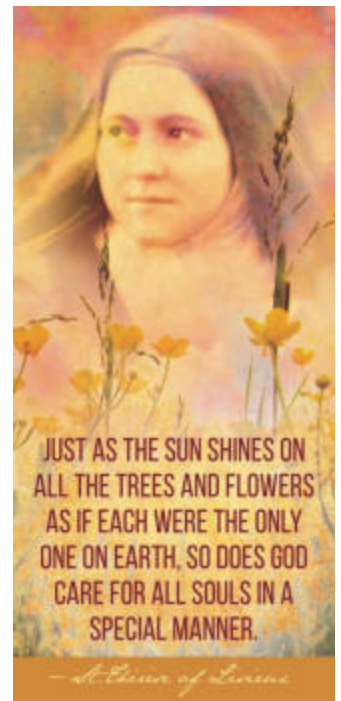
Those seated in the side pews will come forward first, walking up and back by way of the side aisles. We kindly ask these parishioners to walk forward next to the center pews, and walk back to your seat.

Once those seated to the far left and right have received communion, folks seated in the center may come forward, also by way of the side aisle. After receiving the Eucharist, these parishioners will return to their pew by way of the center aisle.

St. Therese of Lisieux
