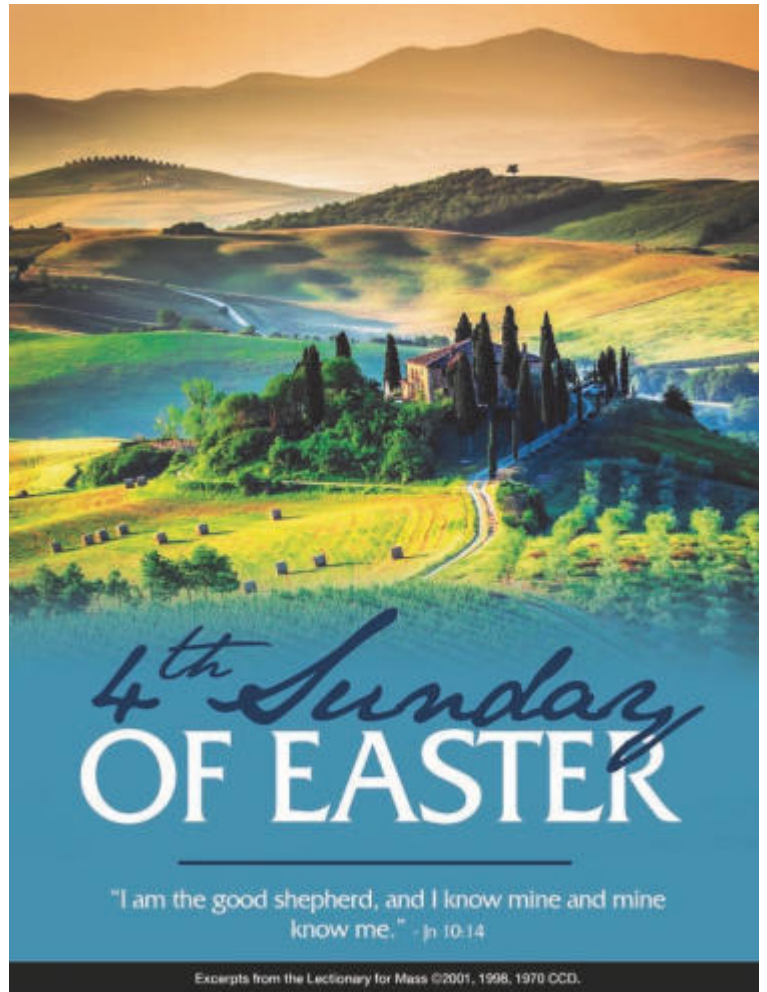

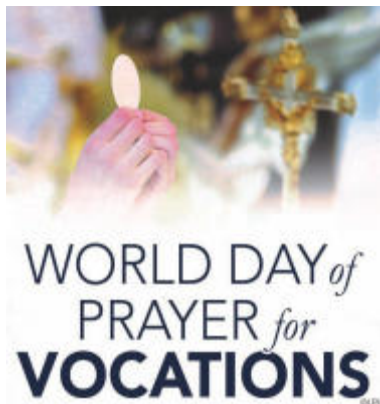
The Food Pantry
