




Sacrament of Reconciliation

Please simply sign-in as you enter the vestibule of church.



As we begin in the freshness and renewal of Spring, our Faith Formation Program will be hosting a drive for needed items for Joseph's House and Shelter in Troy. Joseph's House provides emergency shelter or support services to an average 1,700 men, women, and children yearly.

As a part of our Confirmation classes this year, the students received a virtual presentation from Janet Douglass from Joseph's House to bring about awareness of this non-profit, as well as extreme need in service and donations.

The Food Pantry


