




Dear Parishioners,

I received some good news recently from the Provincial of our Province. A third Augustinian will be joining us here in this community. Fr. Liam O'Doherty will be coming as a Parochial Vicar, to assist Fr. Stanley and me in our work and ministry at both St. Mary's and St. Augustine's. Fr. O'Doherty is a classmate of mine from our early days as novices. REFLECT on the readings

FIRST READING

Moses and the ancient Israelites ratified the covenant God established with them at Mount Sinai with the blood of a sacrificed animal. The sacrificed animal affirmed Israel's commitment: "We will do everything the Lord has told us." Why do you think Israel tied sacrificed blood to their verbal commitment?

SECOND READING

The author of Hebrews teaches us that the sacrificed blood of Christ sanctifies us and offers us eternal redemption. How do you see this connected to ancient Israel's practice of sacrificing animals for their blood?

GOSPEL READING

Mark's account of the institution of the Eucharist is linked to the Jewish Feast of Unleavened Bread when a Passover lamb was sacrificed. What do you think Mark is teaching us in making this connection?


