

Fr. Michael H. Stanley, O.S.A 1951-2022



Fr. Michael Stanley O.S.A., Parochial Vicar of St. Mary of the Assumption Parish and St. Augustine Parish in Lansingburgh, passed away Thursday March 24, 2022 at St. Peter's Hospital in Albany. He was the oldest son of the late Herbert and Teresa Finnegan Stanley and is survived by his brother Richard, his sisters Patricia and Joan, other relatives, and members of his Augustinian community. He was preceded in death by his brothers Philip and Robert.



A graduate of Bonner High School in Pennsylvania, Fr. Michael was ordained in 1981. After his ordination, he served over twenty years in missions in Japan staffed by the Augustinians. Upon his return to the United States in 2002, he was assigned to the parishes of St. Augustine and St. Mary of the Assumption where he faithfully served both communities for 20 years. Fr. Michael will best be remembered for his kind and gentle nature and for the humility he embodied in every aspect of his life and work.

Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon him. May his soul and souls of all the faithful departed, Through the mercy of God, rest in peace.




