





13th Sunday in Ordinary Time/June 26, 2022

First Reading:

Then Elisha left and followed Elijah as his attendant. (1 Kgs 19:21)

We hear today Elijah's call to Elisha to follow him and succeed him as the prophet to lead the Israelite people. Elisha did not hesitate to respond to the call. How have you responded to God's call for you?

Psalm:

Limited Office Hours



Fr. Kelley would not send such a message nor would he ever solicit anything from parishioners by email. Please disregard and delete any such messages.




