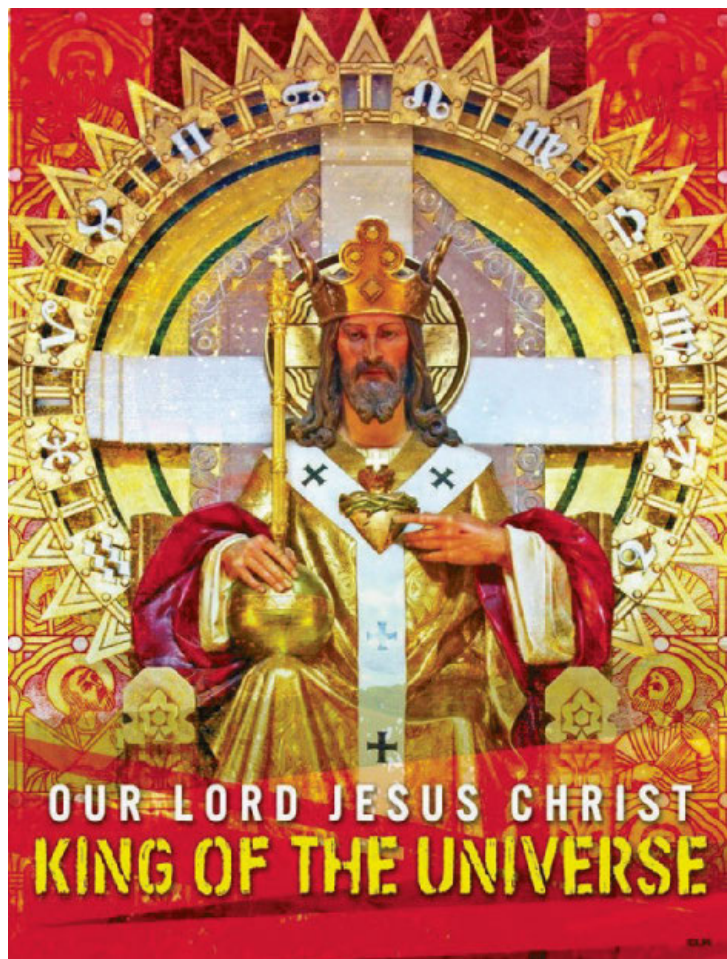

Angels have been placed on the tree. Parishioners are encouraged to take an angel, purchase the

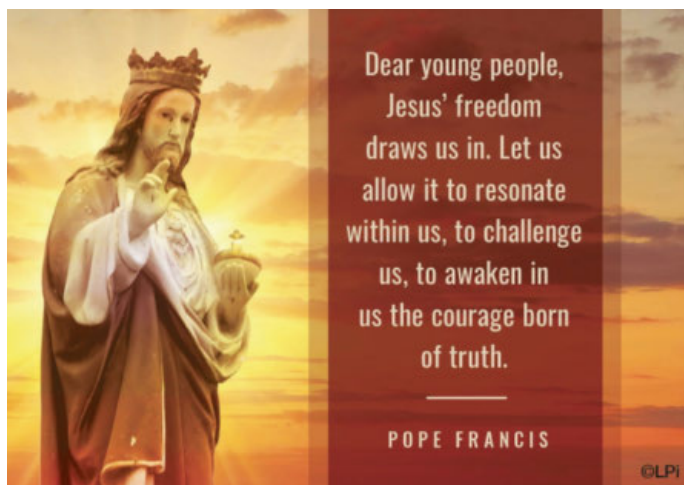
item, and return the item **no later than Sunday, December 16th** as the gifts will be given the following day.


