

As in past years, parishioners are invited to make donations for our Easter Flowers to honor your loved ones. Envelopes can be found in your monthly packets or in the back of Church.


St. Joseph

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

St. Joseph (1st c.) was a descendant of Israel's King David and a carpenter by trade. Scripture tells us that he was a just and virtuous man who was betrothed to wed the young Blessed Virgin Mary. Upon finding her pregnant with the Son of God, Joseph, after a time of uncertainty, was encouraged by an angel to continue with the marriage plans.


Because of his complete faithfulness and obedience to the will of God, St. Joseph was chosen to become the spouse of the Mother of God and the adoptive father of Jesus Christ. As the divinely-appointed earthly guardian and protector of the Holy Family, St. Joseph provided and cared for the material needs of Mary and the Child Jesus.
