



Reflections for Ascension Thursday.....

First Reading:

In Jesus' final words to the disciples before his ascension, he spoke of the central task of being "witnesses" to others of Jesus and the kingdom of God through the power of the Holy Spirit. How might you give witness to others about Jesus and the kingdom of God?

Second Reading:

Paul offers a prayer of thanksgiving to God for the resurrection and ascension of Jesus and for the church, "which is his body." For what should you be thankful to God this week?

Gospel:

In the final scene in the Gospel of Matthew, we hear that prior to his ascension, Jesus told the disciples, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me." Where do you see Jesus exercising his power on earth today?




