

As I said in my last letter, I look forward to seeing you as soon as I possibly can. Until that day, know that I am praying for you just as you are praying for me. I will leave you with words of St. Augustine, which also seem appropriate at this time......

"It is God who always calls us, who always looks for us, who always takes care of each one of us personally".

May God bless each of you with his choicest gifts; the love of family and friends and good health.


