



Confirmation Registrations are important for all 9th and 10th Graders.


For all Catholic High School, 10th Grade Students, who hope to make their Confirmation this year, it is necessary to register early for our planning. Up-coming dates:

October 26th- Grades 1 - 8, Parent Meeting at St. Augustine's Church at 6:30pm.


October 30th- Grades 9 and 10, Confirmation Program, Parent Meeting at St. Mary of Assumption at 6:30pm.
