


Introducing E-Giving!

Things to Know about Electronic giving

- E- giving is a way to donate to St. Mary's electronically, online. As of October 27th, you can donate your offertory to St. Mary's at this link: https://secure.myvanco.com/L-ZNG2 or scan the QR Code below to view the St. Mary's Vanco Giving page.
- The Giving page lists special collections in addition to 'weekly collections'. Simply click on the tile of the collection you'd like to donate to.
- It's secure and user-friendly. When you visit
 the giving page, you can choose what collection you want to give to and how you want to
 donate; ACH Debit or Credit Card.
- Donations can be drawn automatically from a bank account (ACH), which eliminates the need to write checks or get envelopes. This saves you and St. Mary's Church costly check fees and the cost of offertory envelopes.
- Donations can also be made by credit card. If you earn rewards or cash back on a credit card, consider making your donation by this way.
- Receipt of your donation will be sent to your email.
- End of year tax statements will still be provided to families donating over \$250. a year.
- Envelopes will still be provided to families who prefer donating by check or cash in the envelope.
- If you see folks NOT placing an envelope in the collection basket, it may be because they are giving electronically!
- Unfortunately, VENMO is not an option. We apologize for this inconvenience.


